n Evening with Betty Buckley: Betty Buckley is a Tony Award winning Broadway Legend and multi award winning film and television star. When she takes the concert stage, you are undeniably in the hands of a master storyteller and artist who was dubbed the "Voice of Broadway" by New York Magazine. Her concerts with her longtime Arranger and Music Director, Christian Jacob, are a gallery showing of an ever expanding catalogue of their most recent music. The recordings feature an eclectic mixture of story songs. Betty Buckley connects with each and every moment, offering a precious gift of exquisite memories for her devoted fans.

Ms. Buckley won a Tony Award for her performance as Grizabella in Andrew Lloyd Webber's Cats. She received her second Tony Award nomination for her performance as Hesione in Triumph of Love and an Olivier Award Nomination for her interpretation of Norma Desmond in the London production of Webber's Sunset Boulevard, which she repeated to more rave reviews on Broadway. She starred in the Hello, Dolly! First National Tour of the new Broadway production directed by Jerry Zaks. Other Broadway credits include Carrie, The Mystery of Edwin Drood, Song and Dance, Pippin and 1776. She was inducted into the Theatre Hall of Fame in 2017.

On television, Ms. Buckley currently has a recurring role on Law & Order: SVU on NBC and recently guest starred in the new FOX/Warner Bros. Series The Cleaning Lady. She co-starred in the third season of AMC's hit series Preacher and has guest starred in a recurring role on The CW hit Supergirl, the NBC Series Chicago Med, and on ABC Family's Pretty Little Liars. For HBO, she has appeared on Getting On, The Leftovers, The Pacific and for three seasons had a recurring role on OZ. She starred as Abby Bradford in the hit series Eight Is Enough.

Ms. Buckley co-starred with James McAvoy in the M. Night Shyamalan hit film *Split*, one of the top International box office hits of 2017. She received a Saturn Award Nomination for Best Featured Actress for her work in the film. Her other films include Shyamalan's *The Happening*, Lawrence Kasden's *Wyatt Earp*, Woody Allen's *Another Woman*, Roman Polanski's *Frantic*, Bruce Beresford's *Tender Mercies* and her film debut in Brian de Palma's screen version of Stephen King's *Carrie*.

Ms. Buckley has been nominated for three Emmy Awards and two Grammy Awards.

Ms. Buckley tours in concert worldwide with her ensemble of musicians and in 2015 was featured in the Royal Albert Hall concert of Follies in celebration of Stephen Sondheim's 85th birthday. In 2022, Palmetto Records released a compilation album Betty Buckley Sings Stephen Sondheim as a tribute to the late composer. She has recorded an astonishing 19 CD's: including Hope released in 2018, Story Songs in 2017 and Ghostlight produced by T Bone Burnett in 2014. Her album Stars and The Moon: Betty Buckley Live at the Donmar Warehouse was nominated for a Grammy Award.
